Portfolio Requirements

Submit 5 works of art that represent the student's best work THIS YEAR only.

Work may be drawing, paintings or photography. Please do not send sculpture or ceramics.

McNamara's college prep art curriculum focuses on drawing from observation, therefore, at least two of the five submitted works must be a drawing from observation (still life, self portrait using a mirror, a landscape from observation, etc.)

Special Instructions

Work can be on individual pieces of paper, matted/mounted with matboard, or in a sketchbook. Please DO NOT send framed works of art.

Put the work in some kind of portfolio, envelope, binder, or flat container. This does not have to be store-bought, but must be sufficient to keep the work flat, clean, and together.

Put the student's name, phone number, address, and current school on the outside container. Make sure all individual pieces of art have a legible signature on it in case it is separated from the container.

Remember that the scholarship is contingent upon admission to the school and the student must be enrolled in a visual art class as a Freshman. That student must pass the class and may not drop it during Freshman year.

Dates

Drop off the portfolio any time during school hours (7:30am-3:00 pm) during the week of February 11th-15th. All work must be received by 3:00 February 15, 2008. Take the portfolio to the main office.

Work must be picked up no later than 3:30pm February 19th.
